

Emergency cards Bone fracture





- Severe lameness, affected limbs not resilient
- Visible bone = open fracture
- Swelling (with inability to support oneself with the affected limb)
- Altered alignment of the affected limb
- Increased heart rate (>42/min)
- Unwillingness and/or inabillity to stand





Bone fracture Measures

- Call the vet immediately and explain all the details listen to their advise
- Prevent the horse from moving if possible and attempt to calm it down.
- If possible, move the horse to a soft and clean place
- Open fracture: Carefully cover with a clean dressing and bandage to avoid further contamination. (Remember to prioritise your own safety.)
