

Emergency cards Cellulitis





- Severe swelling in the legs, hot or warm and with the possibility of making an impression with your finger in it ("pitting edema").
- Traces of a wound or a breakage in the skin due to an underlying cellulitis, which results in one or several wounds.
- Lameness
- Apathy
- **Fever**





Cellulitis Measures

- Contact the vet
- Measure the temperature to check for fever
- Cool down the legs with either cold hosing, alternating warm- and cold water therapy, osmotic dressing that have the effect of drawing fluid out, hydrotherapy and exercise such as regular walks.
- Do not apply any topical or other treatments without your vet's consent.
