

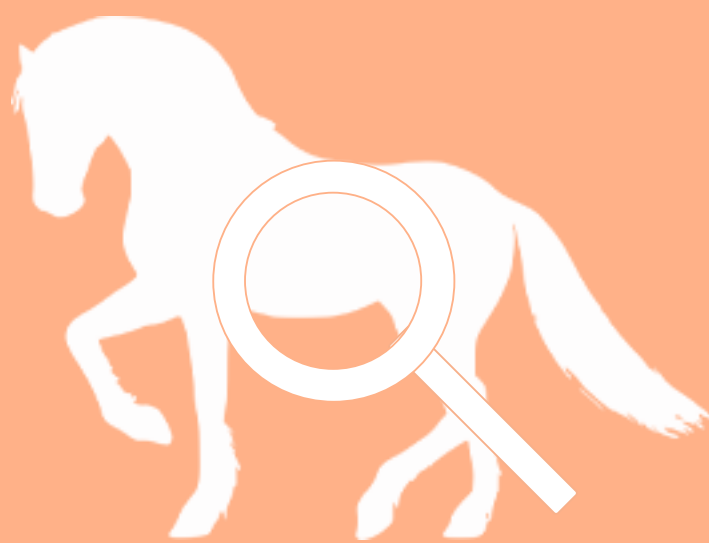

Diarrhea

Symptoms

- + Loose, foul smelling manure
- + Loud gut sounds, flatulence (sometimes no gut sounds)
- + Soiled hindlegs and tail
- + Wet bedding in the stall
- + Fever
- + Signs of discomfort (e.g. rolling, looking or kicking towards stomach, altered breathing, increased heart rate)
- + Altered mucosal membranes (abnormal color, and prolonged capillary refill time (CRT >2 sek)).





Diarrhea

Measures

+ Eliminate the possible cause (e.g fresh pasture grass, large amounts of fruit, moldy forage)

+ Light movement

+ Notify vet upon loss of appetite or colic symptoms

+ If you suspect an infection with salmonella, coli bacteria similar: separate the horse from the others and keep good hygiene for yourself when managing the horse and the environment contaminated with the diarrhea.

+ If it persists, check the electrolyte supply and inform your vet
