
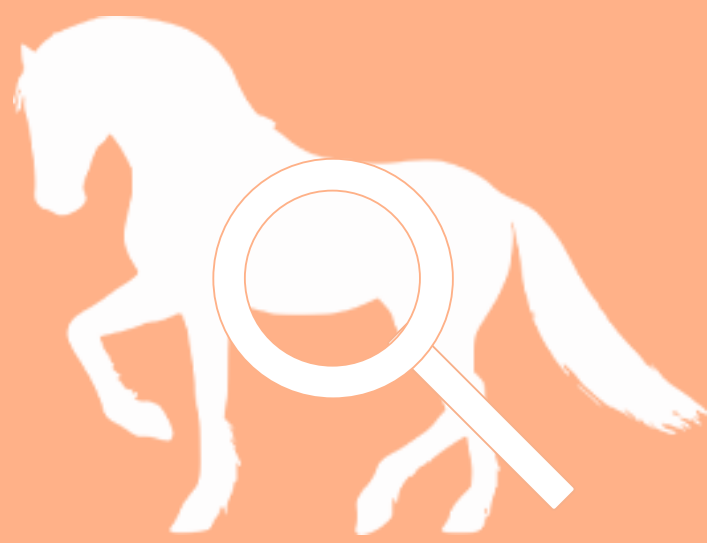

Poisoning Symptoms

- + Restlessness or apathy
- + Breathlessness
- + Colic signs
- + Prolonged capillary refill time (CRT >2 sek)
- + Abnormal color of mucosal membranes
- + Instability and sometimes cramping
- + If the brain is affected: Atypical behaviour (eg. head-pressing against objects, walking in circles, falling)





Poisoning Measures

Measures

- + Prevent further poison intake by removing the horse from the possible cause
- + Call the vet and inform with all known details to the poisoning of the horse.
- + Remove other horses from the source
- + Only offer clean water, until the vet arrives
- + If possible, distinguish the poison or bring the vet a sample
- + In the case of colic signs such as rolling, keep the horse walking until the vet arrives
- + In case of instability and/or significantly altered behavior mind your own safety first as well as the horse's safety.
