

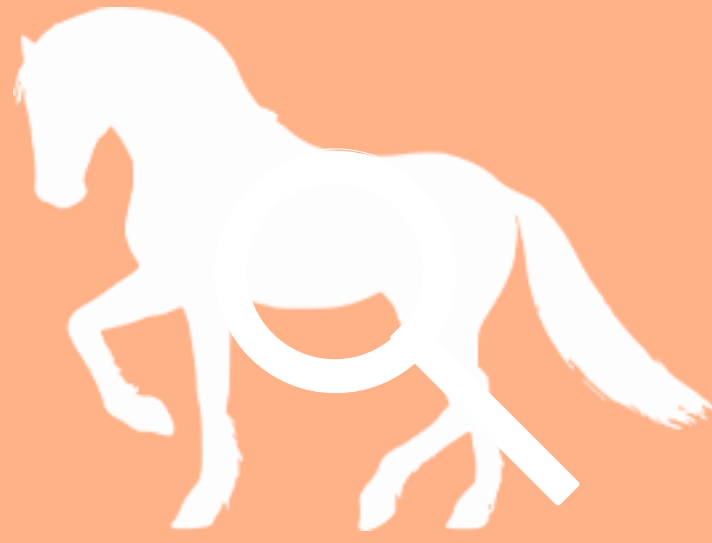

Respiratory Infection

Symptoms

- + Decreased performance, stressed and lethargic
- + Sometimes elevated temperature (>101.3°F in horses, >102.2°F in foals)
- + Flared nostrils without heavy exercise, combined w/ increased respiratory rate - sometimes increased heart rate
- + Cough, nasal discharge, changed pulse, abnormal respiratory sounds, blue/purple mucosa
- + Pain response when poking between the ribs
- + Low appetite
- + Swollen and perhaps sensitive lymph-nodes under and behind the jaw





Respiratory Infection Measures

- + Bring the horse to a well ventilated place
- + Wet the hay, or feed haylage instead
- + Avoid dusty bedding, dirty stables and/or mouldy environments
- + Measure the temperature twice a day and note them.
- + Do not commence any medical treatment without the vets consent
- + Contact the vet to ensure a proper diagnose and treatment of the disease
