
Info Card **TPR-Values**








TPR-Values Info Card

TPR stands for the vital signs temperature, pulse and respiration. They tell you whether your horse is in a stable state. Memorising the average, will help in emergency situations.

Especially the pulse rate at rest varies from horse to horse, depending on breed, age and weight. Determine the values when your horse is healthy, to know it's average.





TPR-Values Info Card

Pulse: 30 to 40 beats per minute, measure on the inside of the jawbone or by placing your hand on the point of maximal intensity of the heart behind and slightly under the left elbow

Respiration: 8 to 16 breaths per minute. Measure by observing the flank movement

Temperature: 99.5°F - 100.8°F (Foals 101.3°F) measured rectally by keeping the thermometer well in contact with the rectal wall while measuring.
