


Emergency cards Tying-Up





- Cramping in the hindquarters
- Firm back, gluteal, and thigh muscles
- Sweating, twitching muscles, resistance to walk or move
- In severe cases the horse can get recumbant and refuse to stand
- Dark brown or black urine





Tying-Up Measures

- Call the vet
- Avoid moving the horse
- Keep the horse warm (especially in cold weather)
- Offer water
- Do not feed concentrated food or any grain, just hay instead
- Let the horse rest until the bloodvalues have normalized
