
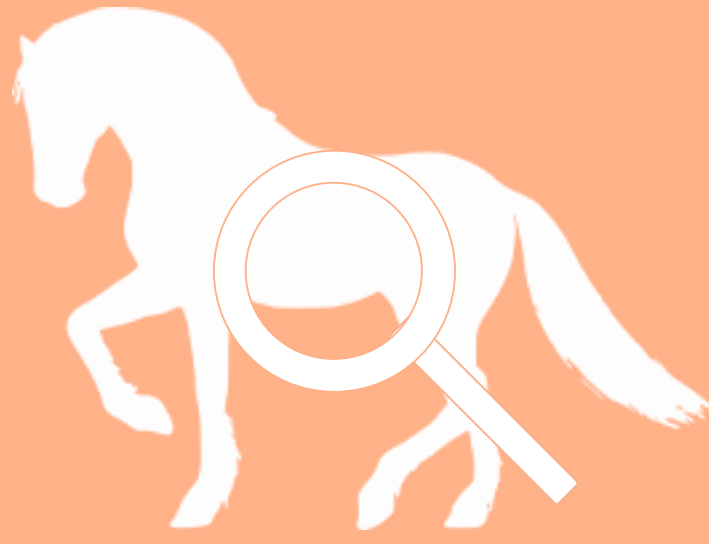

# Tying-Up Symptoms

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- + Cramping in the hindquarters
- + Firm back, gluteal, and thigh muscles
- + Sweating, twitching muscles, resistance to walk or move
- + In severe cases the horse can get recumbant and refuse to stand
- + Dark brown or black urine





# Tying-Up Measures

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- + Call the vet
- + Avoid moving the horse
- + Keep the horse warm (especially in cold weather)
- + Offer water
- + Do not feed concentrated food or any grain, just hay instead
- + Let the horse rest until the bloodvalues have normalized
