
## **Emergency cards Wound - minor bleeding**





## Wound - minor bleeding Symptoms

 Small and superficial wound, where the depth is easy to determine e.g. where the wound can be moved by moving the sorrounded skin

Wound that does not bleed or bleeds only slightly, but may be of considerable depth and penetrate vital structures of joints, tendons, ligaments, etc.

Surrounding area of the wound is not swollen, reddened, hot or showing signs of pain when touching it

No lameness or fever (Indicates that important structures are still intact)

No foreign objects in the wound







## Wound - minor bleeding Measures

Observe the wound- wear gloves to avoid possible contamination

Call the vet if the wound is deeper than just the surface of the skin (wound doesn't move while moving the surrounding skin)

Do not apply any medication without the vets consent

Superficial wound (moves with surrounding skin): Let the natural healing process take its course without too much intervention. Keep it clean and observe it daily. (Wear gloves, avoid contamination)
