



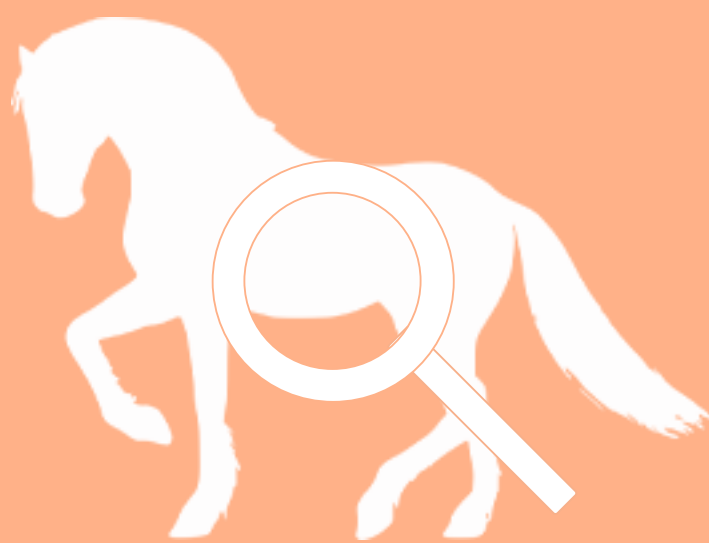

Wound - severe bleeding

Symptoms

- + Strong flow of **bright red** blood leaking from the wound, indicates injury to the artery
- + **Dark red** blood steadily leaking from the wound, indicates injury to the vein





Wound - severe bleeding

Measures

- + Call the vet
- + Artery injury: Apply pressure bandage on the wound.
- + Venous injury: Apply pressure with your fingers for a few minutes followed by a slightly tight bandage.
- + Bleeding on the trunk, head, or neck should be wrapped with a clean towel and bandage to stop the bleeding and prevent contamination.
- + Bleeding from the horse's eyes should be kept out of contamination risk and bleeding from the nostrils can be contained with towels and can last a long time but will eventually stop by itself.
